CCWF's International Child/Parent Development Program (ICDP-USA) Learning Collaborative

Changing Children's Worlds Foundation (CCWF) in partnership with and support of the Kane County Health Department, All Our Kids (AOK) Early Childhood Network, the Juvenile Justice Council and Wells Fargo Corporation will offer a special Learning Collaborative, the first in Aurora for agency professionals to become Trained ICDP Facilitators. This program will provide an introduction to the evidence-based ICDP methodology with a focus on professionals support to strengthen empathy and positive emotional communications and interactions of parents, caregivers, and children.

The ICDP-USA Learning Collaborative supports professionals to effectively engage with families to change intergenerational cycles where families have lacked positive, empathy-based caregiving. Each facilitator will learn to conduct ICDP sessions which span key parent/caregiver-child interactions on Empathy, Caregiver Conceptions of their role and of the child, Social/Emotional, Comprehension (cognitive development) and Regulation (self-control/discipline).
