Legislative Updates – October 2020

HB5810 – Police Training – Social Work

Amends the Illinois Police Training Act. Provides that no probationary police officer beginning employment after the effective date of the amendatory Act shall receive a permanent appointment as a law enforcement officer unless he or she shall have obtained a bachelor's degree with a major or minor in social work.

Filed July 13, 2020

HB5817 – Sch Cd – K12 Books about Racism

Sets forth a list of nonfiction, fiction, and children's books about racism that shall be required reading for students in every public elementary and secondary school beginning with the 2021-2022 school year.

Filed August 3, 2020

HB5826 – Police Nonlethal Force

Creates the Police Department Nonlethal Force Policy Act. Provides that the Illinois State Police, Secretary of State Police Department, and each mass transit district police force, university police force, county sheriff's office, and municipal police department of this State shall develop a plan or strategy for the use of nonlethal force on a person suspected of committing or having committed a criminal offense or resisting arrest.

Filed August 27, 2020

SB1569 – Education various

Provides changes to the School Code in order to compensate for needs related to the COVID-19 public health emergency.
